As per our phone conversation this morning, set out below is an update on the latest ongoing Community Engagement re this project.

1. A web site with full information on all consultation documentation (draft transport assessment, environmental assessment, proposed schools solution, updated masterplan, CGI's etc) has now been completed. It has been made available to the immediately adjacent residents in test format, and will be going live later this week. Password: testsiteonly. The site has a "Have your say" function, so that formal responses can be made on the proposal by all members of the public. Margaret Smith MSP & Councillor Jenny Dawe (as one of the ward councillors) have both asked to be copied in by e-mail on these formal responses. **Can you please confirm which e-mail address and contact details for CEC officers should be put on the web site, to ensure that your Council is involved in this process?**

2. I and Dunedin Canmore Housing Association are presenting to the AGM of Drum Brae Community Council on 9/6/08. As will see from the copy letters, we have made the same offer to Corstorphine Community Council, and await their response.
3. I and Dunedin Canmore have made presentations to; Margaret Smith MSP, Councillor Keir, and Councillor E Aitken.
4. I have contacted all immediately adjacent residents, provided them access to the test web site and my correspondence with their community council, and updated them on current progress. They have been invited to contact me to arrange meetings, so that workshops can be carried out explaining the scheme proposals.
5. A mail shot is going out shortly to all residents who live between Maybury Rd west to the proposal (West Craigs Ave etc) giving them details of the updated proposals, the web site address, and alerting them to future meetings / workshops on the proposal.
6. I look forward to receiving from you suitable dates for addressing both the Almond Neighbourhood Partnership and the Western Edinburgh Neighbourhood Partnership, but I would suggest that the best time to do this is after the Edinburgh Green Belt Study is published. I understand that CEC are taking this to committee during August.

Are there any other mechanisms which you would wish West Craigs Ltd & Dunedin Canmore to explore to ensure full compliance with PAN 81?
